SUBJECTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 6724(b) OF THE CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS:

- Persons under 18 and those who are pregnant must not handle pesticides.
- Safety Procedures to be followed while mixing, loading, applying pesticides. Procedures for handling non-routine tasks or emergency situations.....
- Protective Clothing & Equipment: Coveralls, gloves, goggles, boots, respirator, apron. Equipment cleaning and maintenance.....
- Symptoms of Poisoning: Pinpoint pupils, nausea, shortness of breath, dizziness, headache, Blurred vision. Ways poison or injury can occur.....
- Wash hands and arms with soap & water before eating, drinking, smoking, going to bathroom. Emergency eye flushing techniques.....
- Wash completely at the end of work day. Change into clean clothing. Wear clean work clothes Daily and be aware of pesticide residue on clothing.....
- Understand the immediate and long term hazards involved in handling pesticides & their Known or suspected chronic and acute effects.....
- Emergency medical and hazard information: Name, address, phone # of clinic, physician, or hospital emergency room & where information is located.....
- Medical supervision is required when working for a specified period of time with carbamates, organophosphates with Danger or Warning on label.....
- Read the Label: Signal word, caution statement, first aid, rate, dilution, volume. Follow applicable laws & regulations of labels, material data sheets, & PSIS leaflets.....
- Triple rinse containers at time of use. Never take home pesticide containers used at work. Pesticide Containers must be stored in a locked and posted area with authorized supervision.....
- Drift: Confine the spray to the crop. Work into the wind & watch out for people, animals & Special hazards.....
- Use of engineering controls (closed systems, enclosed cabs, water soluble bags). Location of Pesticide safety info series (PSIS), Material data sheets (MSDS), use records & restricted entry.....
- The need for immediate decontamination of skin & eyes when exposure occurs. Employee rights Against discharge, discrimination & rights to receive information.....
- Knowledge of routes through which pesticides enter the body. Knowledge of prevention, Recognition & first aid treatment of heat stress & heat related illness.....
- Know when, where & how to wear a respirator. You must be trained and evaluated before use. CCR 6739.....
